Welcome to the Strategic Air and Space Museum Overnight Program! We are very excited about this whole event, and we are glad that you will be spending this educational and exciting evening with us!

RULES:

Adult Supervision: Groups must meet a minimum of 1 Adult to a 5 Youth Ratio

DO'S

- You may take pictures during the entire event.
- Bring all gear inside at 6:45PM – (The doors will be locked once the program gets underway and you may not be permitted outside of the building)
- Be respectful to the Museum, staff, and other participants.
- Have a great time!

DON'TS

ALL food and drinks will be consumed **AT DESIGNATED TABLES ONLY**. This will control any spills and will limit clean-up to one area.

- For safety reasons, **you will NOT be permitted to roam free throughout the hangars. Once the tour is completed, the hangars are off limits, unless otherwise stated.** Hangar B will be accessible when the movie is completed if your group is sleeping in the C-119.
- **The following items are not allowed:**
 - ✓ pocket knives / weapons
 - ✓ flashlights
 - ✓ CD players / radios
 - ✓ cell phones (Youth May Not Have)
 - ✓ illegal substances
 - ✓ any type of foot wear with wheels

ADULT SPONSORS: To provide the best experience for all, we require a 5-1 youth to adult ratio. Adults are responsible for any medication participants may need and should have emergency phone numbers for each youth's parent/guardian.

A NOTE FOR THE ADULTS: The Museum will have a full time staff member here throughout the entire Overnight program. However, once the movie is over and the participants are in the C-119, and/or under the SR-71, the participants are completely your responsibility. This means you will be required to stay awake and make sure they are not running around in the Museum. The full time staff member is here for emergency use **ONLY**, not as an additional chaperone.
